INTRODUCTION FROM THE INTERNATIONAL SECRETARY GENERAL



YMI in 2020/21: From Resilience to Transformation and Progress

Winston Churchill once said, “*Never let a good crisis go to waste.*” The COVID-19 global pandemic is a crisis that has tested us, but which has also provided testament to our movement’s health and strength. We did not waste time looking back and lamenting things beyond our control. We saw a time for change, for energy and embracing new opportunities. The mission of our movement, as well as the vision and commitment of its leaders at all levels, continues to inspire us to move forward with visible and impactful actions. While it is hard to quantitatively measure the state of Y’s Men International today, I can confidently say that we are an organisation **moving from resilience towards transformation and progress.**

During the last year, our movement made progress in Extension with 92 new clubs chartered in five Areas. Zimbabwe, Honduras and Burundi were welcomed as new countries into our international family. We bore witness to the establishment of several new IBC relationships and the strengthening of existing ones through online interactions. A significant initiative came from Y’s Men’s Club of Toledo-Central, which, as the first Y’s Men club in the world, is seeking to establish IBC relations with the oldest clubs in all the Areas. Our movement continues to increase its support to YMCAs at this critical time through solidarity funds and volunteerism. The Manual Review Committee was able to update several core documents to make them contemporary and relevant. We activated the collection of money for the Paul William Alexander Legacy, looking towards the purchase of an IHQ office in Geneva and fulfilment of the other projects envisioned under the initiative. In an effort to acquire resources for our centennial, a fundraising campaign was launched, in which Honorary Membership is conferred to club members and friends of YMI in exchange for a one-time contribution of USD 2 500. Our long-cherished dream to have an online supplies store has now been realised. We witnessed great success with the engagement of clubs around the world in the Week4Waste project. We have launched Heal the World as our next Unified Global Project to fight the impact of COVID-19, and the first relief project was implemented in Area India at the District level. With the generous contributions from our members, we could make a major donation of USD 100 000 to the Global Fund to step up our fight against malaria worldwide. We were able to strengthen our digital communication to have information directly reach club members in different languages. YMI was able to successfully conduct the international elections through an online platform with an 86.7 % participation rate by the clubs even during the pandemic. Our international and Area leadership team succeeded in developing a worldwide celebration plan for our 100th year. Our vibrant youth constituency was able to produce a strategic plan for their involvement in activities and elected the IYR through an online election. Virtual platforms enabled us to provide training for APEs, RDEs and Area leaders at different levels during the last few months, and it continues. Our Regional and District leaders made significant progress in empowering clubs to engage virtually and implement meaningful community service activities. Undoubtedly, this is a most exciting time to be a YMI affiliated club member and with deep respect, I bow my head before all Y’s Men leaders around the world for making this happen and **STAYING STRONG AND MOVING FORWARD.**

The year 2021/22 is a very important year for our movement as the year leading to our centenary, and I am sure that we can march together into the new century as a strong movement that has the power to heal the miseries of the world with love and dignity. Yes, YMI will be with the world for now and forever,

The YMI year 2020/21 was different and difficult for us all. We have all been touched and affected by COVID-19. Our lives have been changed more than anyone could have imagined.

As the leaders of YMI, we were challenged to run the organisation concurrently with the pandemic. As we lived with hope month after month, looking for light at the end of the tunnel, we continued to move forward. Many things were changed, postponed or cancelled, but we adapted with new initiatives that made it possible to get through the year in an acceptable way. It was delightful and inspiring to see the creativity of clubs and individuals.

Many meetings at all levels were run virtually; Zoom, GTM and other platforms have become, more or less, normal in our lives.

One of the reasons the year went much better than we expected was due to the efforts of the APs, ISDs and committee/task force chairs. They all worked excellently and purposefully within the limited means available to them. And let's not forget our club members whose hard work impressed me immensely. They created growth on many different levels. Today, I express great satisfaction and gratitude with the words: "Yes, we did it."

On 4 July 2020, I was installed as IP in the Church House in Ringkøbing. My home club members, my family and YMI friends were invited to attend in person, and the event was streamed live to many others. I had the pleasure of installing the ICMs who were watching via Zoom.

"*Trust in the River of Life*" was my IP slogan – words from the Bible, where the energy and power we see in the water and light is compared to the energy and power God gives us and which we use both in YMI and in our private family life.

My logo—the red "Y" with the three words "Values", "Extension" and "Leadership" —was the cornerstone of my IP year. It was produced as a pin, which I had hoped to deliver where I was invited to visit. I received many invitations that I was unable to accept. Due to the pandemic, I spent the whole year in my home in Denmark.

I will highlight some YMI achievements...

- An agreement was reached that ISG Jose will work from the Geneva office and not in the Satellite Office in Chiang Mai.
- A new communication channel was implemented because the old one did not run well. There is a possibility for further evolution and improvement in our communication structure, and a task force is working on the next steps.
- *IP NEWS* was published monthly with information from IHQ, Emphasis Month promotion, Tell the Good Story content and a greeting from the IP. It was delivered in 11 languages with material which I hope was interesting for club members
- The editor for *IP NEWS*, Alan Wallington (Wally) received the Ballantyne Award, merited not only for his work on the IP publication but also for his help given and insight about the movement on many levels and for many years.
- A committee worked and is continuing to work on ideas for 100-years celebration activities at club, Region, Area and international level.
- More focus was given to youth matters through the working collaboration of employed Youth Programme Assistant Tong working from the Satellite Office in Chiang Mai, the ISD for Youth Involvement and Activities Dorina from Kosovo and the new newly elected International Youth Representative Dwight from the Caribbean.
- The old youth programme YEOP was officially closed because it had not been in use for 10 years. A new youth programme called iGo—Internships 4 Global Outreach—has been created.
- We have a plan to purchase an office for IHQ in Geneva, an old dream will be realised.

- The Task Force Towards 2022 and Beyond is working together with a nonprofit company to find out what we have to change in order for us to be more attractive to younger people. 93 new clubs were chartered.
- The employment contract between YMI and ISG Jose Varghese was submitted for renewal. YMI is fortunate to have Jose as Secretary General. He has a great knowledge about the movement and the YMCA. He is thinking and working very professionally.
- The new project, Week4Waste, was implemented across all Areas. Many clubs took part in the project and IP Kim will continue the project in his IP year.

For me it has been a great experience to run the 2020/21 year as IP, with a lot of help from ISG Jose and the staff at the IHQ. They have always been ready to help me—day and night.

First Hybrid Installation

Jacob Kristensen was installed as our 95th International President by PIP Henry Grindheim (IP 2017/18) in YMI's first hybrid event on 4 July 2020. The ceremony was organised by Jacob's club and conducted in-person in his hometown of Ringkøbing, Denmark in the presence of local Y's Men and Women, as well as friends and family, who were able to attend despite the pandemic conditions. It was streamed live to Facebook and made visible on our website and through the coinciding Zoom meeting of International Council Members and other International Executive Officers.



After his installation IP Jacob inducted the 2020/21 International Council Members who participated virtually.

MEMBERSHIP

Thanks to the Membership Campaign and the dedicated efforts of our clubs across the world, we were able to charter 93 new clubs in five of our eight Areas. Three new countries were added to the YMI family: Burundi, Zimbabwe and Honduras so that at the end of 2020/21 YMI was active in 73 countries. Ten new Youth Clubs were formed and Y's Menettes remain strong in their support.

100 Days Membership Campaign

The second annual membership campaign ran again between 1 September and 9 December, offering 50% deduction in international dues to persons aged between 26 to 35¹ joining a YMI affiliated club and extending the existing spouse deduction to clubs of less than 15 members. These special membership prices are valid through the 2nd semester February 2022.

This year's campaign focused on the development of "Glocal Clubs", clubs containing at least one member joining and supporting the club virtually.

The first Glocal Club, welcoming remote members, was created.

Deserving special mention is West District of South India Region for inducting 104 new members in one day. Congratulations DG Mathesh Rajan and all clubs in the West District.

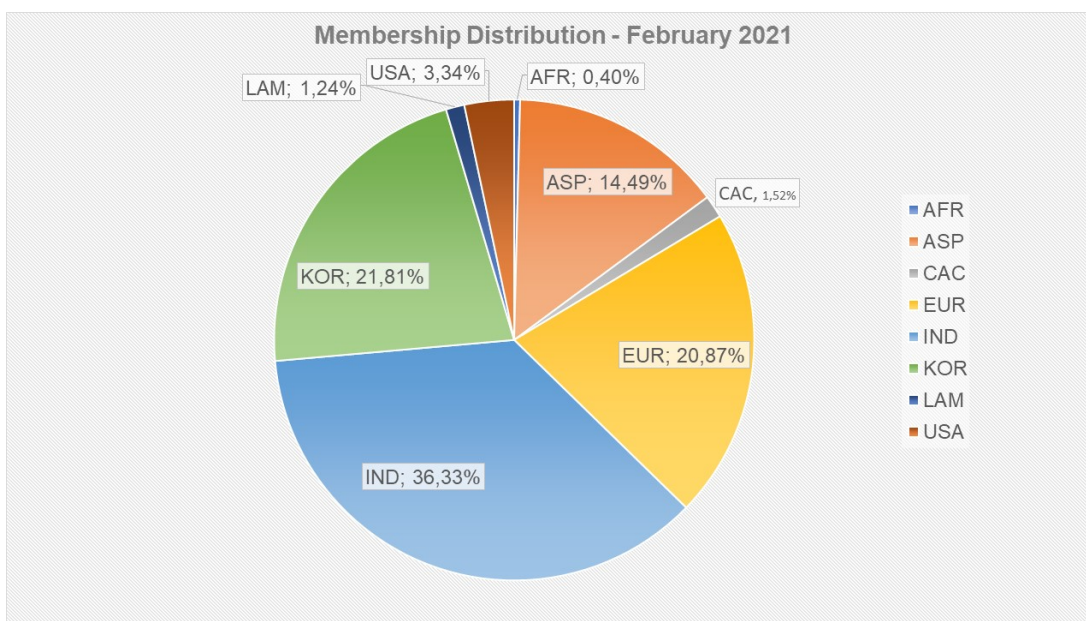

YMCA

The year began with the allocation of CHF 10 000 at the end of July to the YMCA Solidarity Fund from the International Alexander Scholarship Fund to support YMCAs struggling to remain open and functioning due to the pandemic.

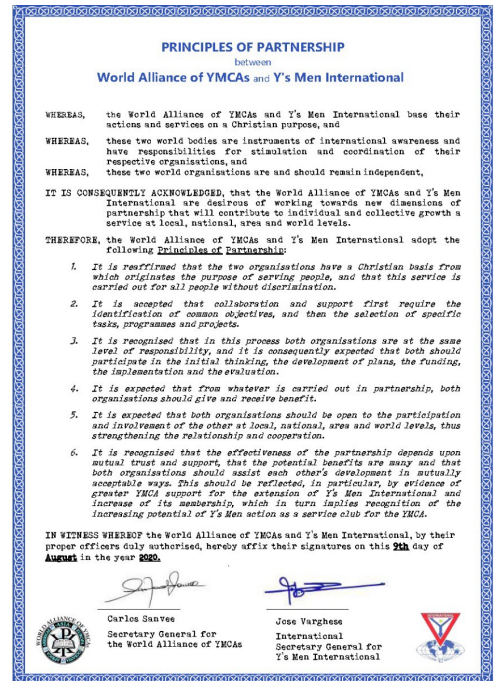
In August, the Principles of Partnership agreement between World YMCA and YMI was re-signed by ISG Jose and Secretary General of the YMCA, Carlos Sanvee.

In October, YMI participated in the first Youth Led Solutions event with Area USA and International providing funding of USD 3 000 and USD 2 000 respectively to support a workshop on climate change. We participated in several other similar YMC workshops throughout the year.

A special Zoom meeting with the YMCAs in West Africa was arranged, leading to the formation of new clubs in Ghana and Togo. Subsequently, contact and support to the YMCAs in Myanmar and north India also led to stronger organisational relationships and the formation of new clubs.

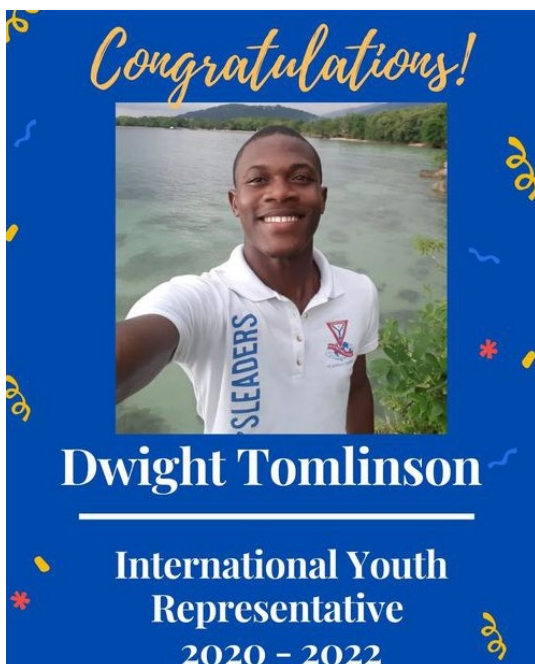

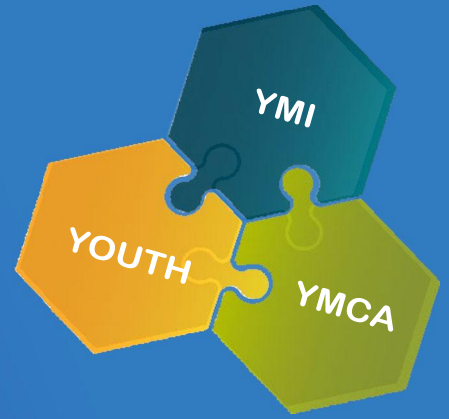
Y's Youth

In addition to the engagement in the YMCA Youth Led Summits, YMI Youth kept active and engaged in a variety of ways, primarily participating in COVID-19 relief activities, such a food delivery to the housebound, educational campaigns, mask distribution, etc.

Y's Youth across the world participated in the YMI world cleanup project, Week4Waste, and kept connected through the youth Facebook group created by International Service Director for Youth Involvement & Activities, Dorina Lluka Davies, other social media applications and the "Youth World" magazine. Various youth meetings and convocations were held at the various levels despite the pandemic.

Y's Menettes

In 2020/21, the Y's Menettes once again acted as a strong and committed champion of the YMI vision and mission.

In February, the Y's Menettes successfully concluded their project with the YMCA in Tirana Albania – “Coaching for Youth Employment and Starting of a Social Business”. Launched in 2018, the YMCA, with the support of the Y's Menettes' investment, helped to guide local young people in the establishment and management of a coffee shop, providing materials and relevant education. The original pledged amount was CHF 28 630 to which the Y's Menettes graciously added another CHF 6 000 when the November 2019 earthquake damaged the original premises, resulting in unforeseen liabilities and forcing the business to relocate.

During the 2020/21 year the Y's Menettes also worked towards the completion of its other international project – “Sports and Informal Education as Tools of Healthy Lifestyle Promotion among Vulnerable Children at Zaporizhzhia, Ukraine” officially approved in 2020 for CHF 15 000 to support the creation an outdoor play and fitness area for socially disadvantaged children with compromised health.

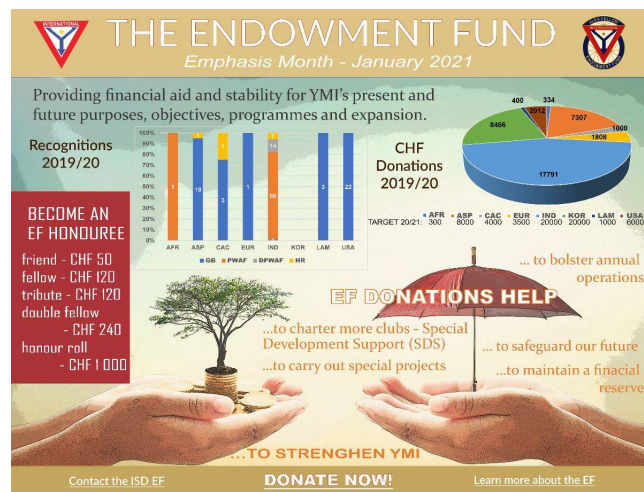
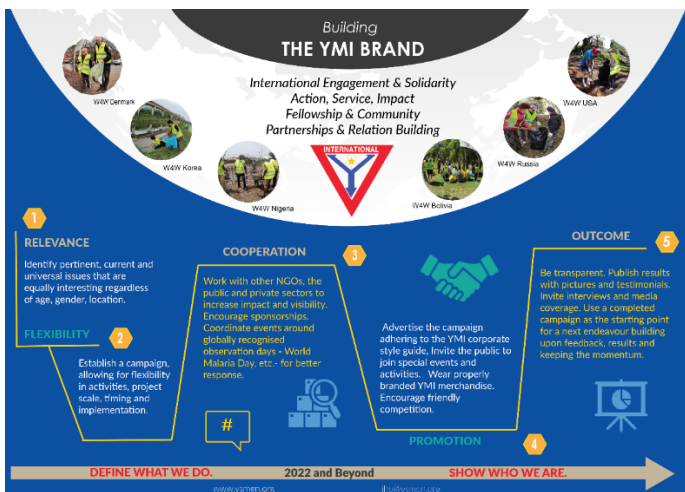
Publications

IP News bulletin was published monthly in the major languages of the organisation thanks to the dedication of volunteer editor, Alan (Wally) Wallington.

The quarterly publication, *YMI World* was produced under the excellent guidance of Editor Koshy Mathew who also created with his District, Bangalore II, the much-appreciated Y's Men International *Information Nuggets*, a series of 50, one-page informational notes about our movement that were distributed to members each month.

Youth Programme Assistant Tong Phontudsirikul expertly produced three editions of “*Youth World*” that were appreciated by both YMI Youth and our regular membership.





Emphasis Months communications were released monthly from the international office, taking the form of flyers, videos, web content, etc.

Nine publications receiving the attention of the Manual Review Committee (MRC) were approved by the International Council. Among them were several new documents, including a Membership Orientation Guide, an International Youth Convocation Manual and a TOF promotional booklet.

Written materials were enhanced by the production of several new programme videos (TOF, RBM and HTW) which can be viewed on YouTube channel or accessed via our website.

Meetings

The 2020/21 year was filled with many virtual meetings at various levels. Since the onset of COVID-19, YMI has introduced regular Zoom discussions with AP/Es, ICMs, ISDs and our various committees, task forces and working groups.

The Mid-Year meeting invited AP/Es, ICMs and ISDs as observers, giving birth to a new protocol now written into our Guideline 407 of our International Constitution:

The participants in the Mid-Year Meeting shall comprise the International President, the International President-Elect, the Immediate Past International President, the International Treasurer (and Treasurer-Elect when relevant), as well as the Secretary General. Area Presidents and/or Area Presidents-Elect may also be requested to participate. The International Service Directors, Committee and Task Force chairs, and other special guests shall be invited as observers whenever possible.

It was with sadness that we had to postpone plans to hold the second RDE Summit which was to take place in South Korea. A Zoom version was held 29 – 30 May.

Unfortunately, after much deliberation and soul searching, the decision was made to cancel the International Convention planned for Hawaii in 2022. Gratitude was duly expressed to the Host Committee, Region Hawaii, the USA Area and all others who had been working diligently to try to find a workable plan for hosting an in-person/hybrid event. Unfortunately, the ongoing pandemic conditions made the realisation of this event too great a liability. In its place a centennial celebration event is being planned for mid-November 2022 in Taipei Taiwan.

PROGRAMMES AND SERVICE

Paul William Alexander (PWA) Legacy

Special focus was given to, and progress made towards, realising two PWA Legacy projects.

A contract was signed with Focuz Infotech in Ernakulam, India for a customizable digital library product meeting our budget and product expectations. Scanning and archiving historical documents held by IHQ, the International Historian, as well as the Areas and Regions, will begin in 2021/22.

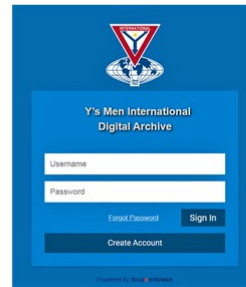



IHQ Office

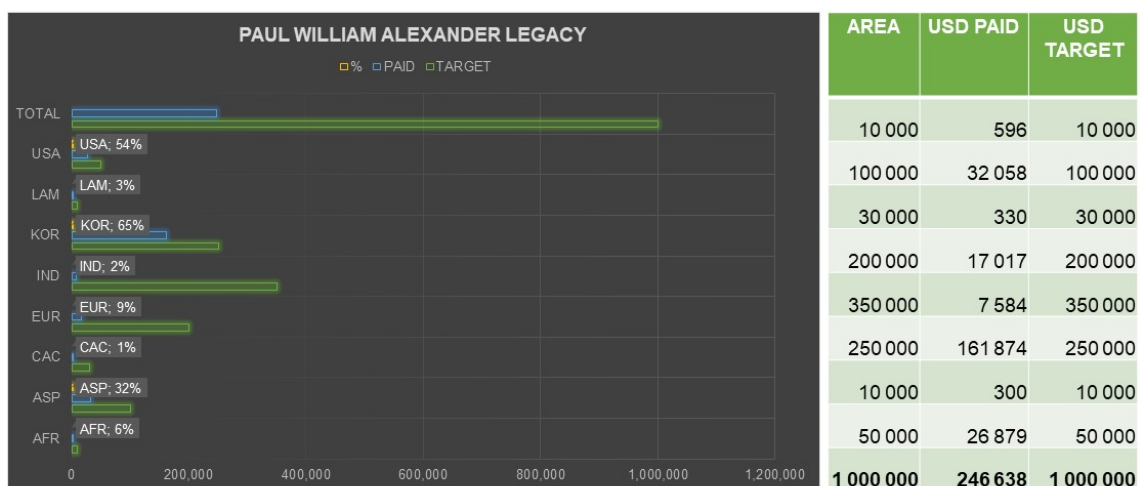
After selling the headquarters building in the United States more than 35 years ago, YMI has been renting its office space. Reasons for investing in property were identified.

Owning our headquarters is attractive as:

- Provides patrimony and stability for the movement.
- Mortgage to rent comparison is favourable. Mortgage rates are very low in Switzerland.
- A good investment opportunity. The real estate market is such in Geneva that an eventual sale of the property should bring a good return.
- Can be managed as an asset by the EF Trustees.

ISG Jose and staff began exploring the Geneva real estate market with the encouragement of the IEOs and the chairperson of the Endowment Fund Trustees. Several potential properties were visited, and investigations began regarding legal, fiscal and administrative impact of ownership. In May, the International Council authorised the identification and negotiation of an office space in Geneva.

Honorary Members and Centennial Celebrations

The Secretary General, with the approval of the International President, may confer on a person the status of "honorary" membership in recognition of his/her past or present assistance in the furtherance of the International Association of Y's Men's Clubs. In 2020/21, the special YMI Centenary Fund was created. 100 honorary memberships will be conferred against USD 2 500 from individual, clubs, YMCAs, etc. for implementing Centennial Service Projects worldwide as part of the Paul William Alexander Founder Legacy initiative. Identified purposes include:

- To celebrate our global movement, our rich heritage, and our journey together
- To recognise long-serving clubs and club members
- To mobilise resources for PWA Legacy projects
- To improve YMI's image and visibility.



The Centenary Celebration Team drafted and published a booklet of ideas for celebrating our 100 years at the club level. They also created a dedicated Facebook page to circulate event initiatives and photos.

Heal the World

The Heal the World initiative of IP Kim Sang-chaе was launched. Area and Regional leaders were introduced to the associated digital meeting and discussion platform. The policy and operating guidelines for the new Unified Global Project were drafted giving special consideration to projects in the health, building and emergency relief sectors from 2021/22.

When the second wave of the coronavirus hit in India, a special HTW appeal was made. In the space of a few weeks, more than CHF 20 000 was raised to support matching-fund projects, mainly in India, but also in other locations severely impacted by COVID-19 in the later half of our Y's Men year. Face masks, oximeters, PPEs, and food staples were collected and distributed in many locations thanks to the special, emergency COVID-19 appeal.

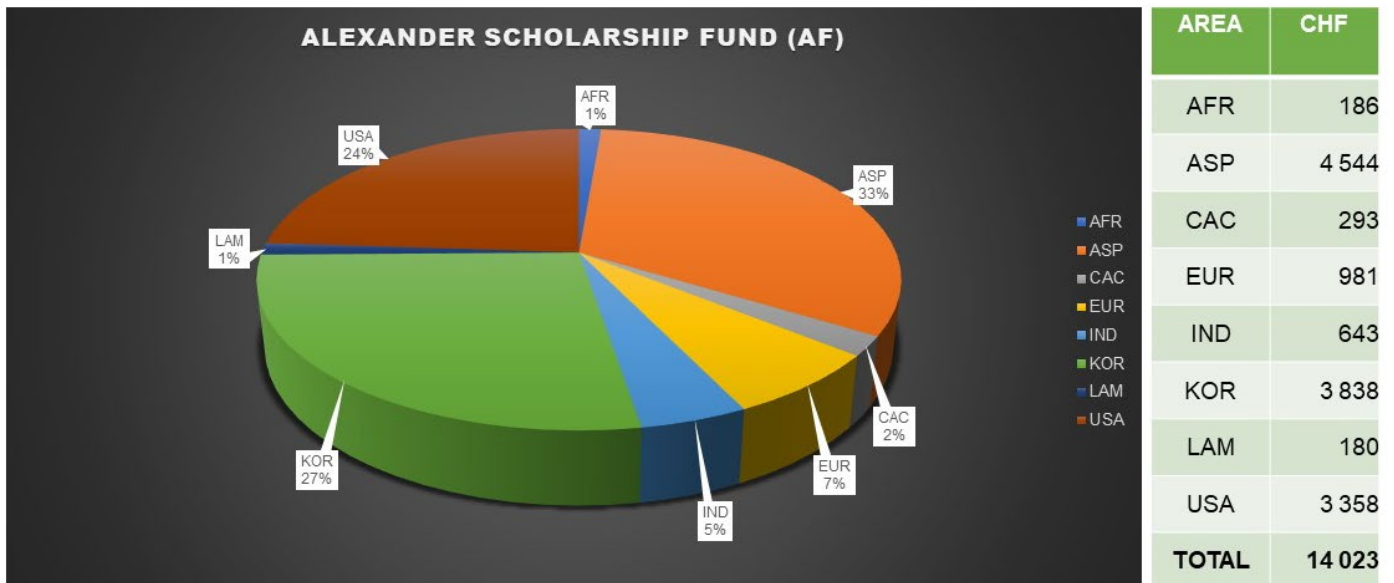

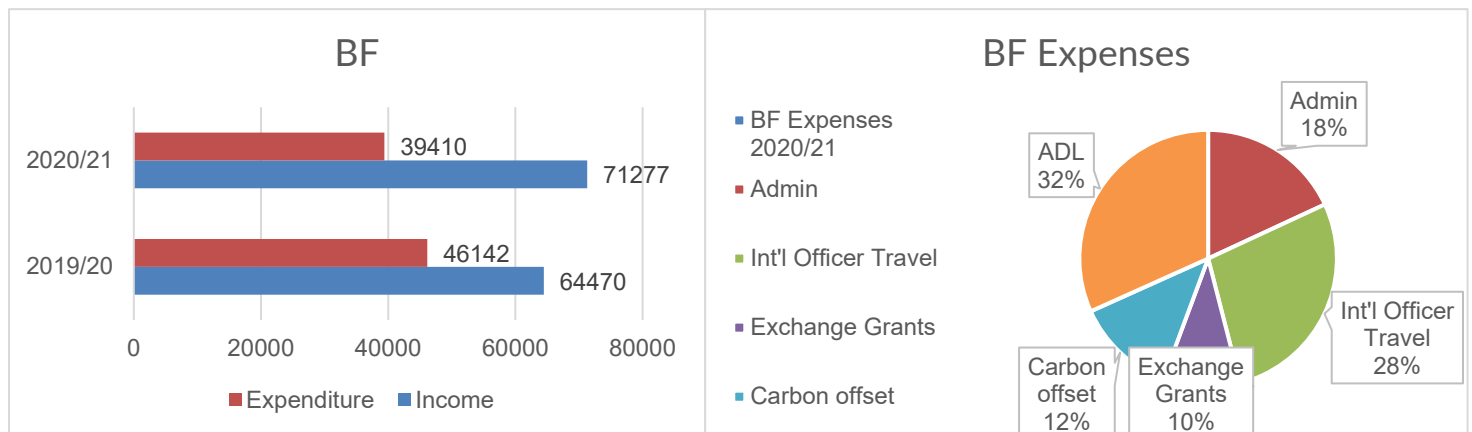

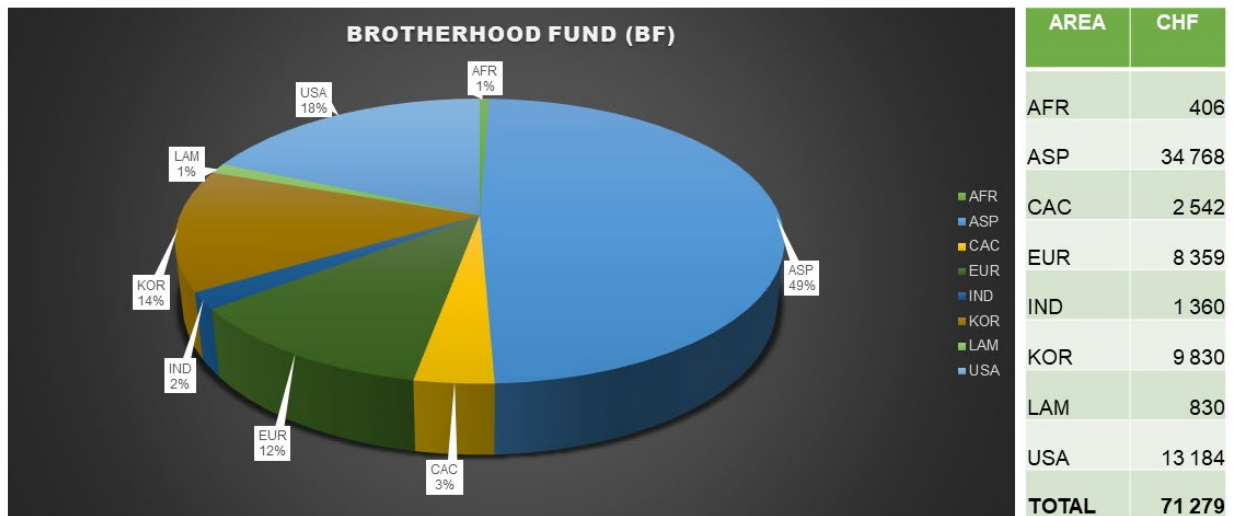
The international ASF contributed CHF 10 000 to the YMCA's COVID-19 Solidarity Fund in 2019/20, providing salary and operational support to YMCAs most impacted by the coronavirus pandemic.

Brotherhood Fund (BF)



Due to COVID-19 no BF delegate travel occurred in 2020/21. Several trips approved before the pandemic remain pending and will be conducted as soon as conditions allow. In 2020/21 the traditional Cultural Exchange Grants were replaced by a temporary category of funding as travel remains restricted in all parts of the world. The Brotherhood Expenditures Committee received nine complete and variable applications for BF General Grants in 2020/21 of which six (across 4 Areas) found to honour the BF purpose were recommended for financial support.

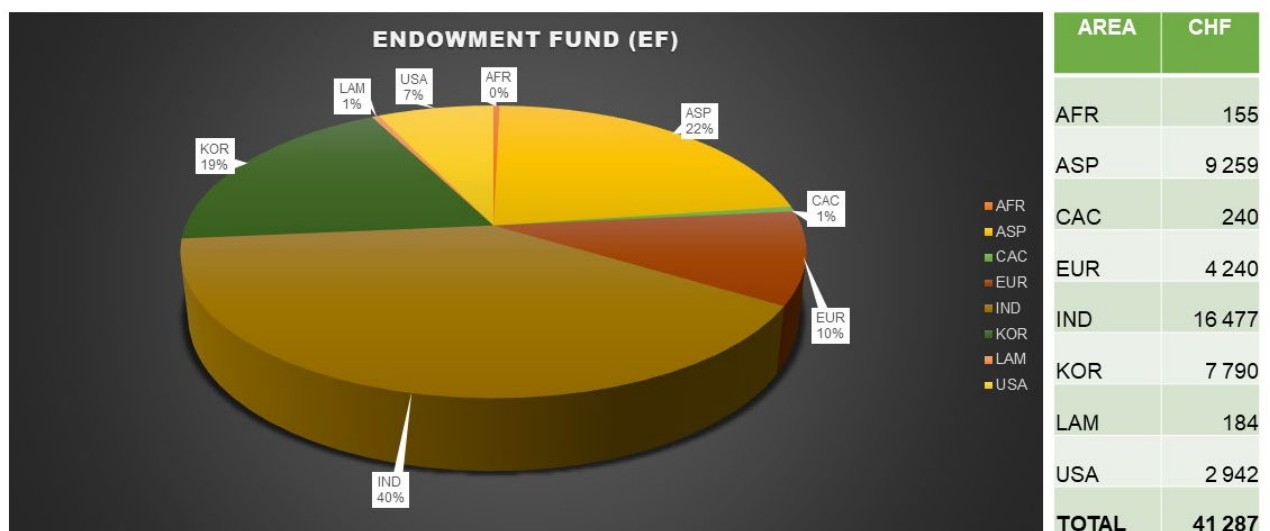

Special recognition was given to **District Governor Benny Augustin of Bangalore II District**. Under his leadership three new clubs were chartered in previously unexplored areas. He increased District membership by 26% by inducting 91 families. He is honoured particularly by IP 2020/21 Jacob for his image building programmes and community initiatives that have increased YMI's visibility and public understanding of our movement in local communities.
