FOREWORD FROM THE INTERNATIONAL SECRETARY GENERAL



2021/22 was a year of Healing! It began with the peak of the COVID-19 pandemic and the loss of several of our club members and leaders. The inspiring theme of our IP Dr Kim Sang-chaе, *Heal the World with Dignity and Love*, guided us to come together to build resilience and bring wellbeing and hope to all. Through Heal the World, our current UGP, we supported COVID-19 response programmes in India, Nepal and various places in Latin America.

It was a year of celebrating our journey together! Excited by the approaching centenary, we began celebrating with meaningful projects and friendly gatherings. Club-level festivities during the first week of May gave good opportunity for fellowship and meaningful projects locally. Area level projects implemented in Asia Pacific, India, United States and Korea were high impact and increased our visibility.

It was a year of envisioning the future! A long-cherished dream of once again possessing our own IHQ property for movement prominence and sustainability was realised with the purchase of office space in Geneva. An ICM working group formulated the new Strategy 2032, providing a blueprint for YMI's development over the next 10 years. Another working group has begun the complex process of modernising our International Constitution and organisational structure. A revised BF policy was established for inspiring leadership and building fellowship.

It was a year of Igniting growth, leadership, fellowship, and impact! This year, 103 clubs were chartered, including the first new club in Canada in more than two decades. Our club membership surpassed 25 000. We re-established our existence in Greece, Ethiopia, Indonesia, and Qatar for a global presence in 76 countries. A significant initiative came from YMCA Toledo which initiated a new club with young members. It is exciting to note that Areas Asia Pacific, Korea, Latin America and United States all recorded an increase in membership.

We bore witness the establishment of several new IBC relationships and the strengthening of existing ones through online interactions.

We continued to build our support to YMCA through solidarity funds and volunteerism. With generous contributions from our members, we could make a major donation of USD 100 000 to the Global Fund to step up our fight against malaria worldwide. Our Regional and District leaders made significant progress in empowering clubs to engage virtually and implement meaningful community service activities. Clubs around world once again enthusiastically participated in the Week4Waste project.

To raise resources for our centennial, the Honorary Membership campaign was launched. At the end of the 2021/22 year, thirty-four persons, as well as the Mandal Club and the World YMCA had contributed.

Another significant achievement was the establishment of the Digital Archives. Some international documents have already been uploaded. Area and Regional administrators are being appointed

Lastly, it was indeed a blessed opportunity that we could hold an extraordinary ICM and International RDE Summit with over 75 participants in Dubai. This ignited the Y's Men spirit, and we are looking forward towards another year of fellowship and impact under the leadership of IP Dr K.C. Samuel.

MESSAGE FROM THE INTERNATIONAL PRESIDENT 2021/22



Dear families of Y's Men International,

Greetings from your IP 2021/22.

The year 2021/22 may have been one of the most difficult in the history of our movement. I began my tenure looking forward to a year of fellowship, celebration, and good deeds in our communities and around the globe. I chose the slogan *Heal the World with Love and Dignity* seeing the world fragmented and suffering due to the COVID-19 pandemic. I sincerely believed that by enhancing fun and fellowship in club life, we could overcome anxiety, strengthen the overall health of our club members, and be resilient in these unprecedented times. As the world struggled with the pandemic challenges, I saw an opportunity to increase our presence on the global stage and raise awareness of YMI as a truly international service organisation. I dreamed of global volunteerism, transcending national borders and the integration of global projects. Accordingly, my Heal the World programme (which advocates for humanitarianism, community service, networking, capacity building, and worldwide impact) was launched and performed well in various communities, including Korea, India, and Latin America.

In addition, 2022 marks the 100th anniversary of Y's Men International, and it has always troubled me that YMI's long history and legacy is virtually unknown when compared to that of the YMCA. Questions and uncertainty about our identity have always been with us. This was another reason why I prioritised improving our public image and branding through movement growth and vibrant and active clubs.

Other highlights include the remarkable progress made in India to build organisational cooperation with the YMCA and the extraordinary ICM and the second International RDE Summit successfully held in Dubai in May, the first physical international meeting in two years. The RDE Summit gave opportunity to some 80 attendees to build friendships and reflect on each other's responsibilities. The introduction of Strategy 2032 at that meeting created a roadmap for the next decade, and we are working hard to lay the groundwork for the next century. At all levels, 100-years events and activities were planned and executed. New songs, legacy stories and videos, anniversary rosters and more are being prepared. Lastly, we were able to purchase office space for the IHQ, ensuring the stability of the organisation's operations.

Thanks to the tireless efforts of leaders at all levels and IHQ, we succeeded in maintaining the YMI spirit around the world and continued to prepare for the next century. Most Regions formed new clubs while retaining or expanding existing club membership. As of the end of June, there were 103 new clubs

I hope that our movement will achieve historic and sustainable growth under the leadership of Dr K.C. Samuel and that we build our presence and impact in the areas of health, environment and education as outlined under Strategy 2032 and Heal the World.

I hope to see you at the long-awaited 100th anniversary celebration to be held in Taiwan in March.

2. Promotion of community service activities.
3. Membership Growth.

KEY DECISIONS AND ACTIONS

The following are some of the key decisions taken by our legislative body during the 2021/22 year related to the overall function and management of YMI.

Conventions and other meetings

- Decision to cancel the International Convention (IC) originally to take place in Hawaii in August 2022 (voted by Council in July 2022)
This replaced the former decision to postpone the IC until 2023 as it was felt that the pandemic situation and the ability of the Hawaii Region to coordinate the event within budget was compromised.
- Decision to hold an international centennial celebration event in Taipei, Taiwan in the 2022/23 YMI year (voted by Council in July 2022)
With the cancellation of the IC in Hawaii but still a strong desire to have in-person centennial event, the IEOs considered several proposals to host from the Asia Pacific Area, including Hong Kong, Chiang Mai and Singapore before recommending Taipei. The dates of 15 to 17 November were proposed, being the same dates as the original convention in Atlantic City, New Jersey in 1922.
- Decision to accept to the only bid (from South India Region) to hold the International Convention 2024 in Bangalore, India and to appoint PIP Moon Sang-bong as the chair of the International Convention Committee (voted by Council in July 2021).

Dues Extension

- Decision to extend to 31 October the first semester payment deadline due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic (force majeure) and relative to participation in the international elections. (Voted by Council by online ballot)

IHQ Office

- Revision of the original purchase budget of CHF 1 500 000 originally approved in May 2021 to CHF 2 300 000 (voted by Council in December 2021)



YMI has been renting its office space for more than 35 years and has spent more than CHF 1 500 000 on rent. On 18 May, we signed agreement to buy 134m2 of floor space just minutes on foot from the Lac Léman in a historic building close to public transportation, including the central train station. The price was just CHF 970 000. An estimated CHF 350 000 will be needed to transform the space into an office environment. Plans that include several private as well as shared working spaces, small meeting room and kitchen have been drawn up by an architect and been submitted to department issuing construction and renovation permits.



Constitutional Matters

- Approval of the Constitutional Review Committee Procedure for New or Amended Area/Regional Constitutions as drafted by the Constitution Review Committee to be disseminated from IHQ to the Areas and Regions (voted by Council in July 2022)
- Introduction of a new Guideline 309 (with the current 309 being renumbered 310) revoking the membership of any club which fails to conform to the law and rules of Y's Men International by consensus of the IEOs and ISG after an investigative process and by majority vote of at least two-thirds of the International Council (voted by Council in July 2022)
- Approval of two amended Area constitutions, Asia Pacific and Canada/Caribbean (mail ballot)
- Approval of the bifurcation of South India into South and South Central and subsequent Regional constitutions (mail ballot)
- Approval of three amended Regional constitutions: Latin America, West India, Mid West India (mail ballot)
- Agreement that the group reviewing the International Constitution submit its final report at ICM 2023 (voted by Council May 2022)

Modernising our International Constitution and our Organisational Structure

A special working group, consisting of Council Members Bjørn Arve Bentsen (chair), Shanavas Khan A., Rosanna Croci Reyes, Shaju Sam, as well as IPE K.C. Samuel and ISG Jose Varghese and IHQ staff James Olle, was convened with a first commission to conduct a thorough review of our International Constitution. The objective was to develop recommendations to simplify, update and make more effective this essential document framing the governance of our international organisation in a modern context.

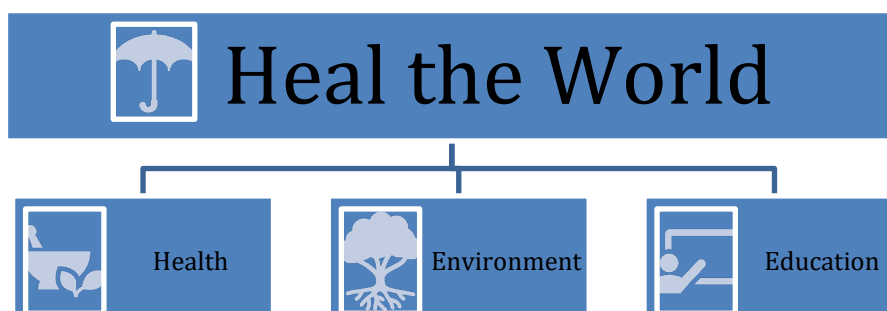
While some initial recommendations related to Articles I – VI, (unopposed by the Constitution Review Committee) were shared at the May ICM in Dubai, no formal decisions were taken. The Council, recognising the complexity of the group's commission, requested that it continue its work in 2022/23 and makes its final report to ICM 2023.



Forward Planning

A second working group, consisting of Council Members Tom Waka (chair), Seham Rabaa, Villy Moelgaard, Joseph Kottooran and Park Sung Chul, as well as IP Kim Sang-chae and ISG Jose Varghese and IHQ staff Tracy Movigliatti were commissioned to create a vision statement and plan to replace Towards 2022. The result, Strategy 2032, was introduced and accepted at the May ICM in Dubai. [Read the full strategy.](#)

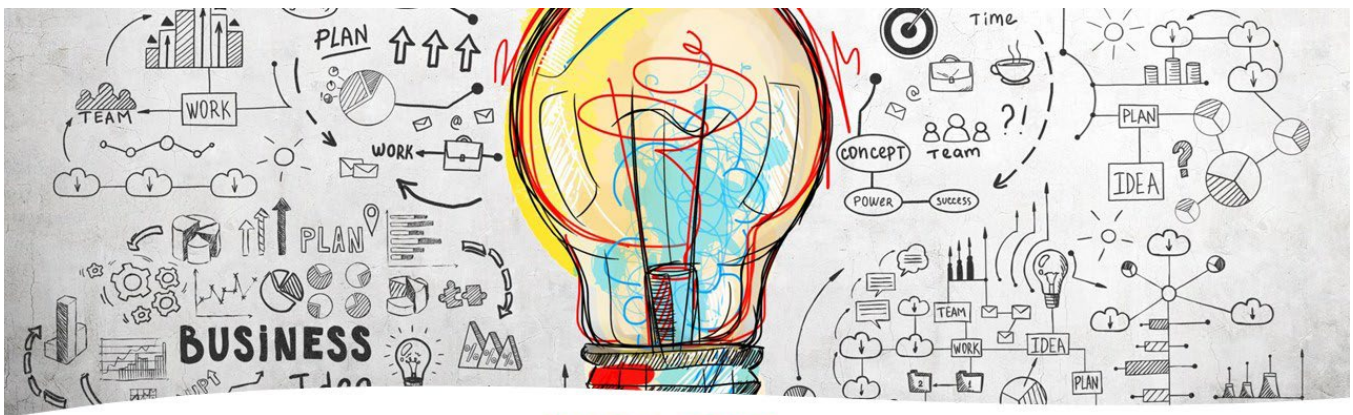
The group introduced its concept for a ten-year blueprint for organizational development by first reviewing the qualities that define our movement and identifying areas for change.

Review of International Programmes

A third working group comprising International Council Members Brian Minielly (chair), Anand Jacob Verghese, Kim Han Seob, Nathalia Novak Vilela, as well as IPIP Jacob Kristensen, IT T.M. Jose and IHQ staff Tracy Movigliatti. Brian presented two proposals at the ICM in Dubai:

- Creation of a new task force to oversee an independent review of each of our core international programmes, studying their relevance, looking at outcomes and impact to finding ways to make them more flexible and attractive
- Creation of a general communication team to develop ways to better use modern media options, including content and design improvements to our website



NB: As a result of this feedback groups were formed to review the Alexander Scholarship Fund, the Endowment Fund and Time of Fast and a new Impact Communication Team was established by ICM 22 under the direction of Dr. K.C. Samuel.

Review of the Brotherhood Fund Policy

- Decision to rename the Brotherhood Fund as Building Fellowship programme with a new corresponding logo and tagline and to accept the proposed policy changes (voted by Council May 2022)

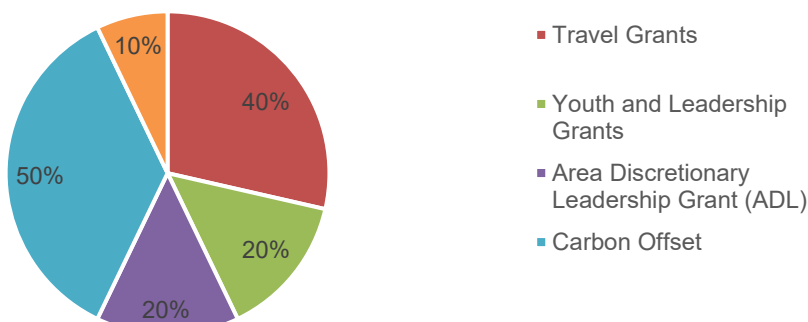


ICM 2021 appointed a special one-year task force to review and make recommendations to improve the Brotherhood Fund programme. This group was chaired by ASP AP (2020/21) David Lua and had as its members past BF leaders and representatives from each of the eight Areas (AFR Dr Sherif Shoukry Awad, CAC Earl Foster, EUR Ineta Krumina, IND Philips Cherian, KOR Hans Il-wook, LAM Sonja Marly Müller, USA Bobby Stivers-Apiki, as well as ISG Jose Varghese and IHQ staff Tracy Movigliatti.



Beyond the change the name and logo, other accepted proposals included a simplification of the grant categories and funding allocations, as well changes to the awards system to make it more inclusive for the poorer income locations.

BF INCOME DISTRIBUTION FROM 2022/23



New Club Level Awards

- BF Bronze Award – 2 points
- BF Silver Award – 5 points
- BF Gold Award – 10 points
- BF Platinum Award – 20 points

Points given:

- Cash donation – 1 point per CHF 40 per club
- Cash from Stamp Sales – 1 point per CHF 10
- Each BF delegate hosted in the preceding year – 4 points
- Club with approved BF grant in the preceding year and having submitted a travel report – 2 points

The Ernie Bell and Alf Reynolds Award will be converted to the Regional level.

NEW VISION STATEMENT

The fund aims to build fellowship among club members and inspire leadership in the YMI movement.

Extraordinary Council Meeting and International RDE Summit

In May 2022, YMI was able to hold its first physical meeting in more than two years. While only one ICM is mandated annually by the International Constitution, additional meetings may be called by the IP or by a 20% majority of Council Members.



This meeting provided a framework for fruitful discussion on the findings of the three working groups as noted in the preceding pages and to identify and deliberate on other international matters, such as conflict resolution and image building.

The meeting was followed by the RDE Summit which welcomed more than 75 persons, including more than 80% of the incoming Regional Directors, all Area Presidents for the 2022/23 year and some special guests such as former PIPs. The Harry M. Ballantyne Award from the 2020/21 year was officially presented to Alan “Wally” Wallington. The RDE Summit combined training with interactive sessions, guest lecturers and special dinners and fun leisure activities, generously hosted by IP Kim Sang-chaeh, IPE Dr K.C. Samuel and AP India Mr Anand Jacob Verghese.



OUR GLOBAL PRESENCE

The third annual membership campaign ran again between 1 September and 9 December, offering 50% deduction in international dues to persons aged between 18 to 35 joining a YMI affiliated club and extending a spouse deduction to clubs of less than 15 members. This year's campaign introduced the centennial extension concept.



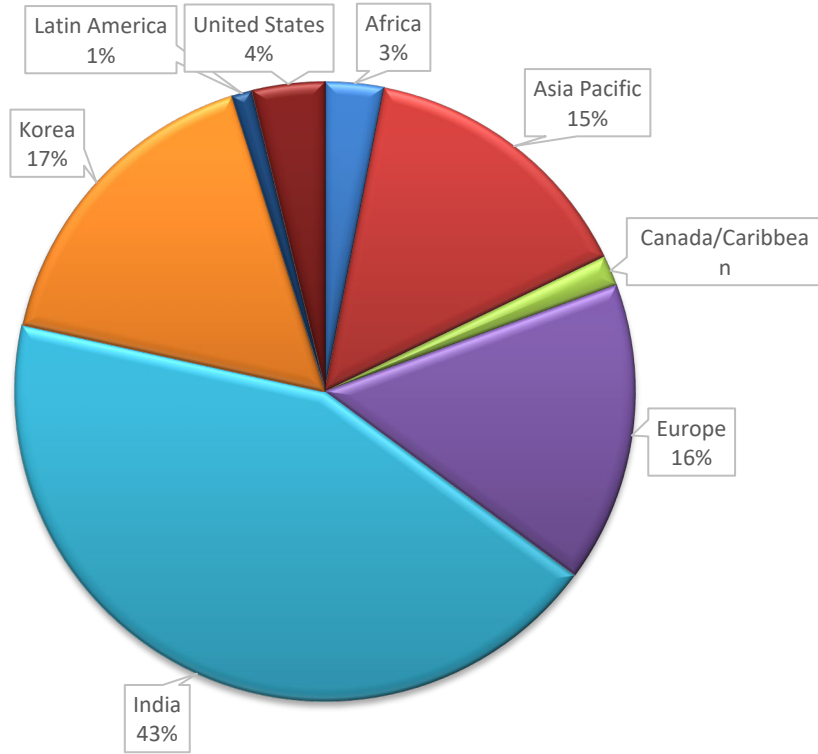
Thanks in part to the annual Membership Campaign and the dedicated efforts of our clubs across the world, we were able to charter 103 new clubs in six of our eight Areas. Region North Atlantic (USA) deserves special recognition for the new Pennsylvania club chartered with an impressive 64 members in November. We celebrated five clubs having 100 or more members in 2022/23: Mandal in Norway with 129, Kolenchery and GCT Youth Coimbatore with 101 and 104 respectively, and Gim Hae Helpers Seven and Jeonju Jeonil with 153 and 100.



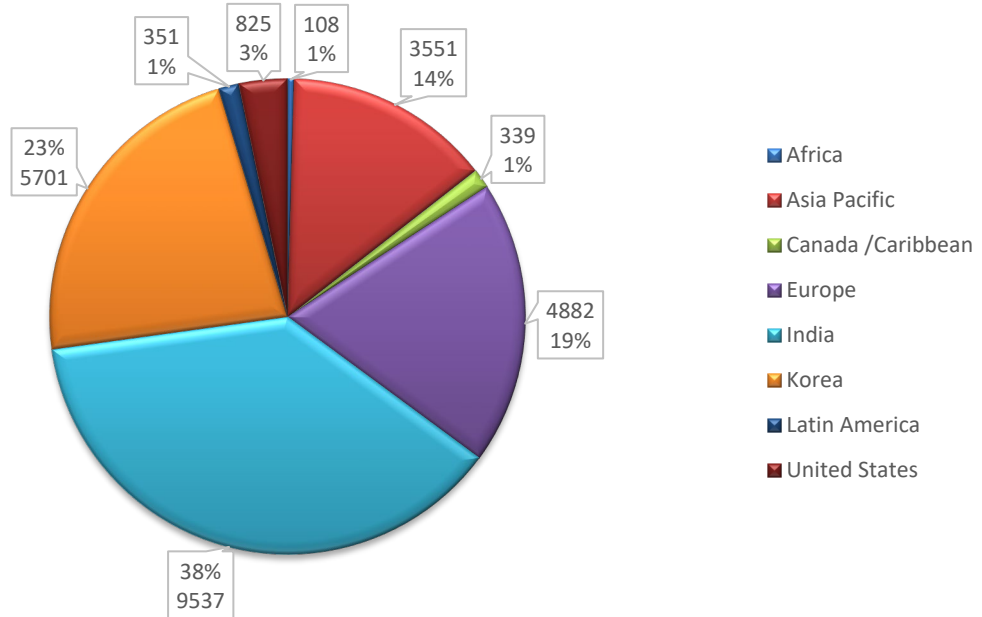
Unfortunately, we lost 137 clubs. Africa and Korea had the distinction of gaining more clubs than they lost.

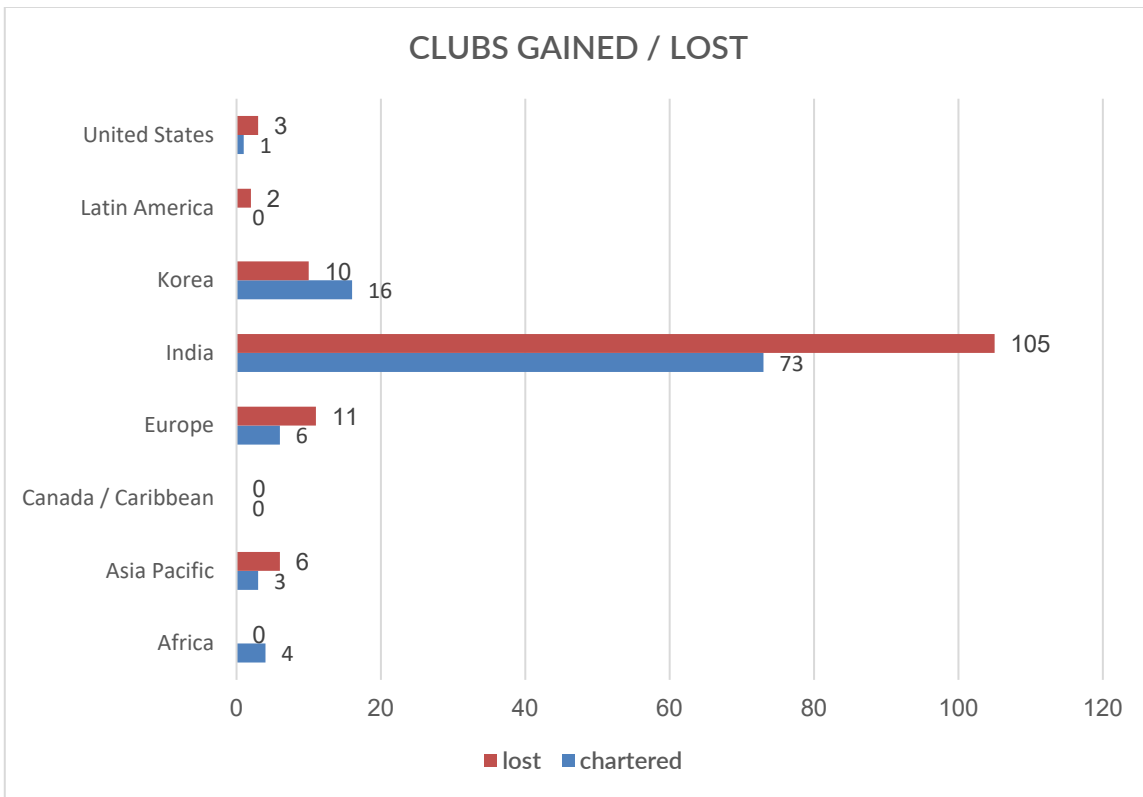

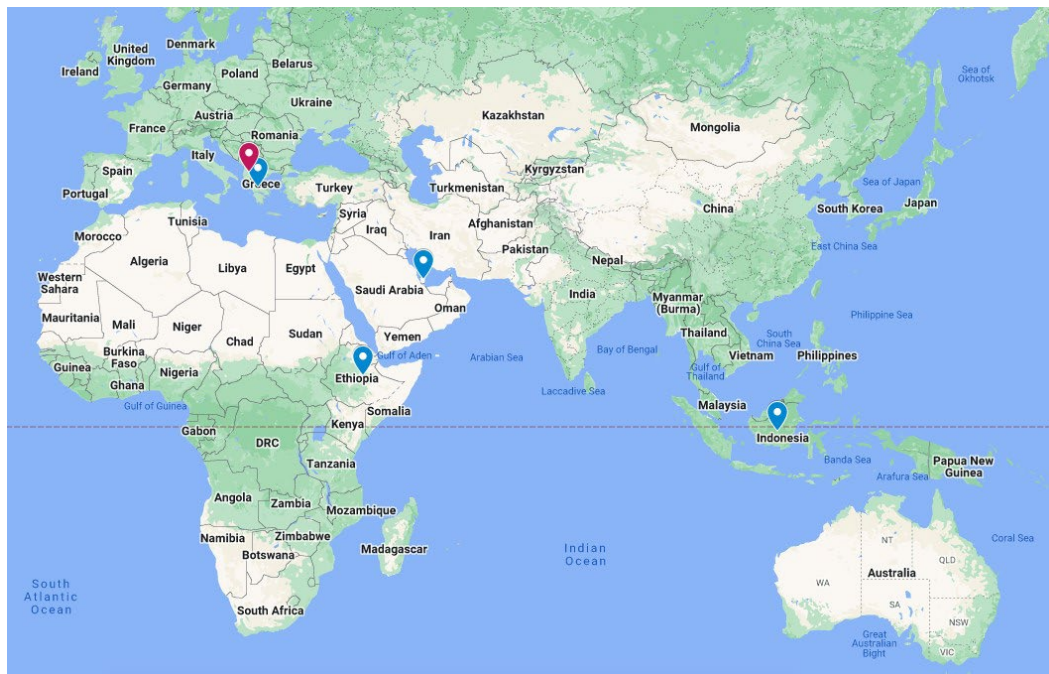

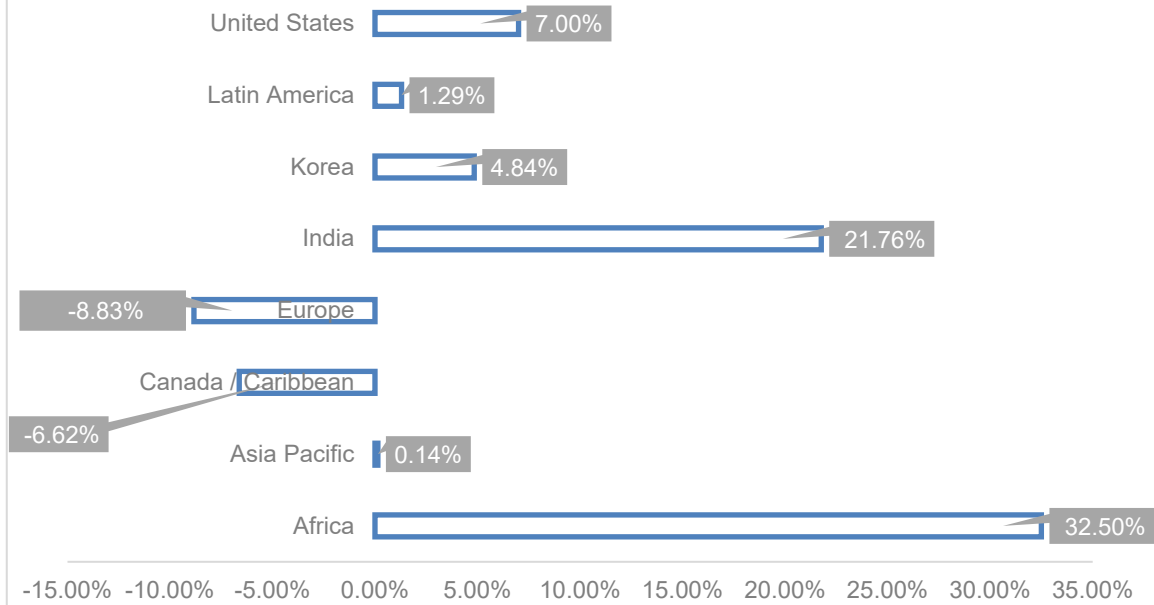

RELATED TO OUR CENTENNIAL

The Secretary General, with the approval of the International President, may confer on a person the status of "honorary" membership in recognition of their past or present assistance in the furtherance of the International Association of Y's Men's Clubs. In 2020/21, the special YMI Centenary Fund was created offering 100 honorary memberships against USD 2 500 from individual, clubs, YMCAs, etc. for implementing centennial service projects worldwide. At the end of June 2022, thirty-six honorary memberships had been bestowed, including one to the World YMCA.

Local Celebrations

2021/22 saw many preparations for and "pre" celebrations of our 100th the year as a registered service organisation. A few activities included awareness-raising fairs and festivities; installations of YMI monuments; notable key-note speakers and guests such as former UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon; creation of special centennial merchandise; writing and production of 100-year songs; and of course, the baking and eating of cake, as well as much more).

Some Areas are now fully invested in their own centennial activities, which include a solar panel project in the Philippines, a food bank in the USA and dialysis distribution in India.

Sri Lanka: When the Waters Subsid

December 2004 is a hard time to recall for many in South and Southeast Asia. This is when an undersea earthquake of magnitude 9.1 off the coast of Sumatra sent a storey-high wall of water rushing across the Indian Ocean to hit shores as far as East Africa. Some surviving witnesses claim that tsunami wave reached as high as nine metres. Sri Lanka, which was one of the most affected countries, counted 30 000 mortalities with about five percent of the total population affected by the catastrophe. Many houses were destroyed, leaving thousands, often also grieving and trying to assimilate the loss of loved ones, homeless and without worldly possessions overnight.



Relief operations were quickly initiated, and as always, Y's Men International rose to the occasion. Joining with organisations such as Foundation for Goodness created by Kushil Gunasekaran, YMI united to build homes for those who had lost theirs in the disaster. Donations were collected during Sri Lanka's 29th Regional Convention from the Area and international levels. Approximately USD 100 000 from club members across the globe would eventually be allocated to the cause. Local Y's Men and Women, some victims themselves, worked on

tirelessly on site, coordinating with local government officials to solve such issues as the location and zoning for the construction.

Finally, three years later, in a special ceremony on 18 June at the 31st Regional Convention, fifteen houses were handed over to the tsunami victims at Weligama. This inspirational story of solidarity with impact concluded with the keynote address of Mr Gunasekaran at the Region's next convention. YMI had delivered on its words of hope to the survivors.

These celebrations will continue in the year 2022/23 and are marked at the international level by the ongoing development of 100 legacy stories, a brief historical video series, and a “Golden Member” roster of active club members who have been Y’s Men and Women for fifty or more years.



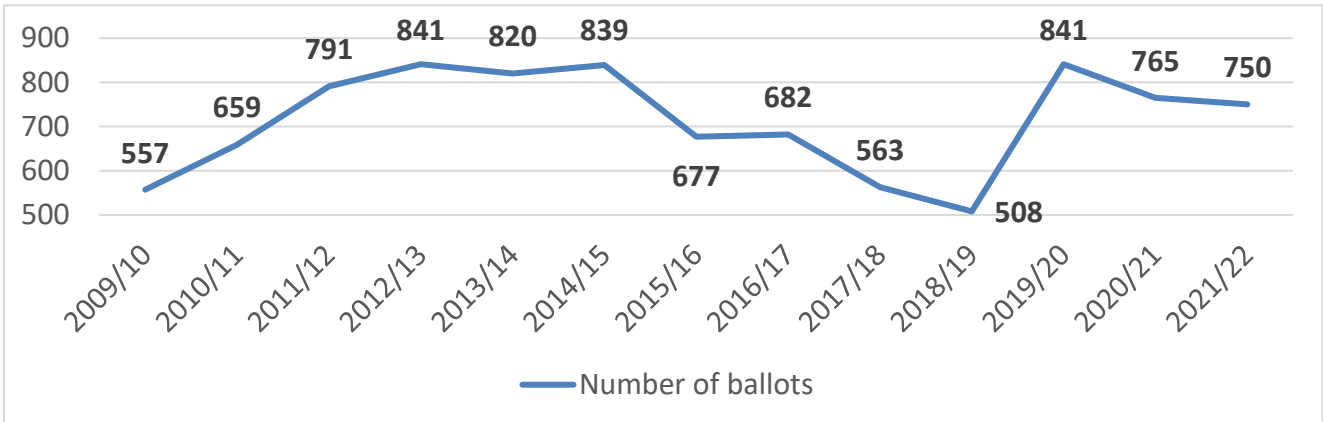

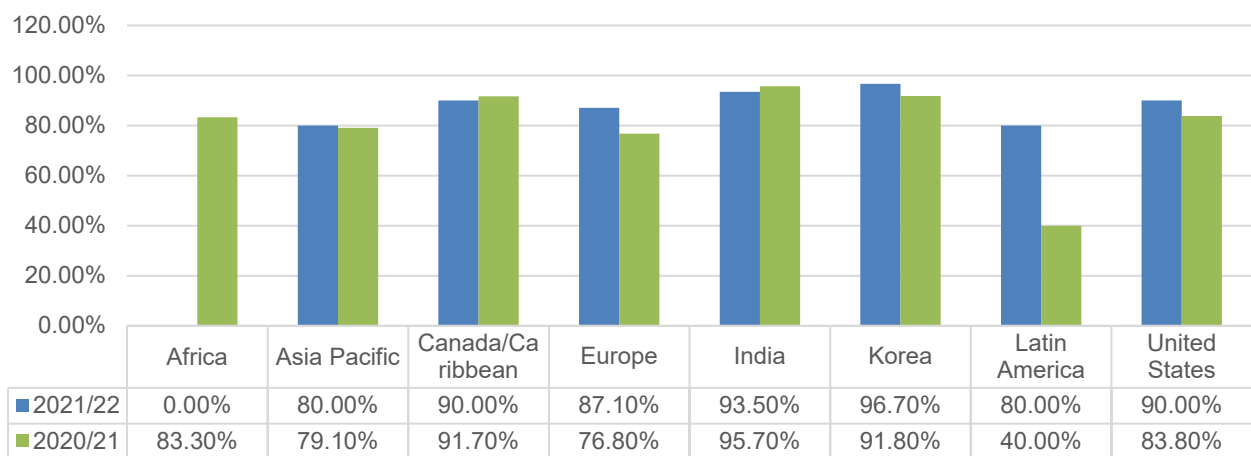

PROGRAMMES AND PARTNERSHIPS

Core Programmes

Y's Men International currently maintains five core international programmes: the Alexander Scholarship Fund (ASF), Building Fellowship (BF) (formerly the Brotherhood Fund), the Endowment Fund (EF), Roll Back Malaria (RBM), and Time of Fast (TOF).

Contributions to ASF, BF and EF increased from last year by 3.16%, 1.60%, and 50.49% respectively. Contributions to RBM and TOF decreased last year by 2.36% and 8.51%.



Alexander Scholarship Fund

Since the mid-1950s, the Alexander Scholarship Fund (ASF) has been providing primarily educational grants to YMCA professionals, those seeking to join its staff or in support of its collective training missions. The ASF is unique in that only 30% of the money raised at the local level is payable to IHQ.

In 2020/21, CHF 10 000 was donated to the YMCA's COVID-19 Solidarity Fund to support National Movements struggling due the pandemic. This support was duplicated in 2021/22.

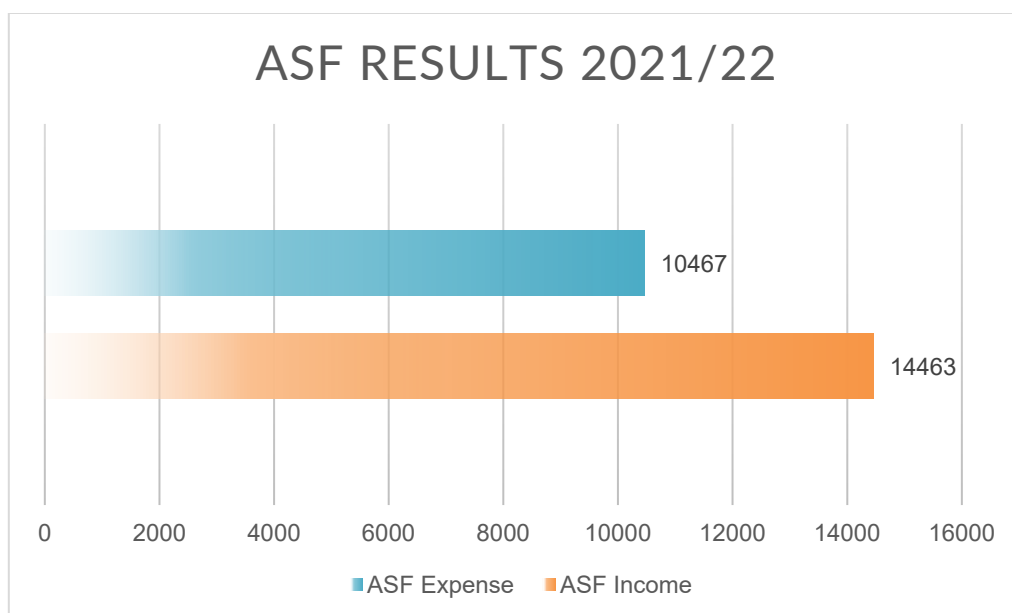
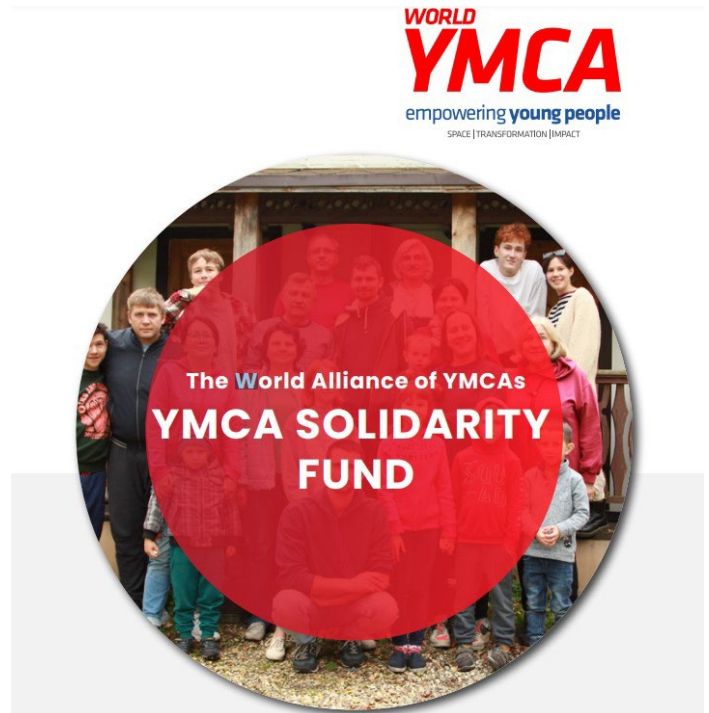

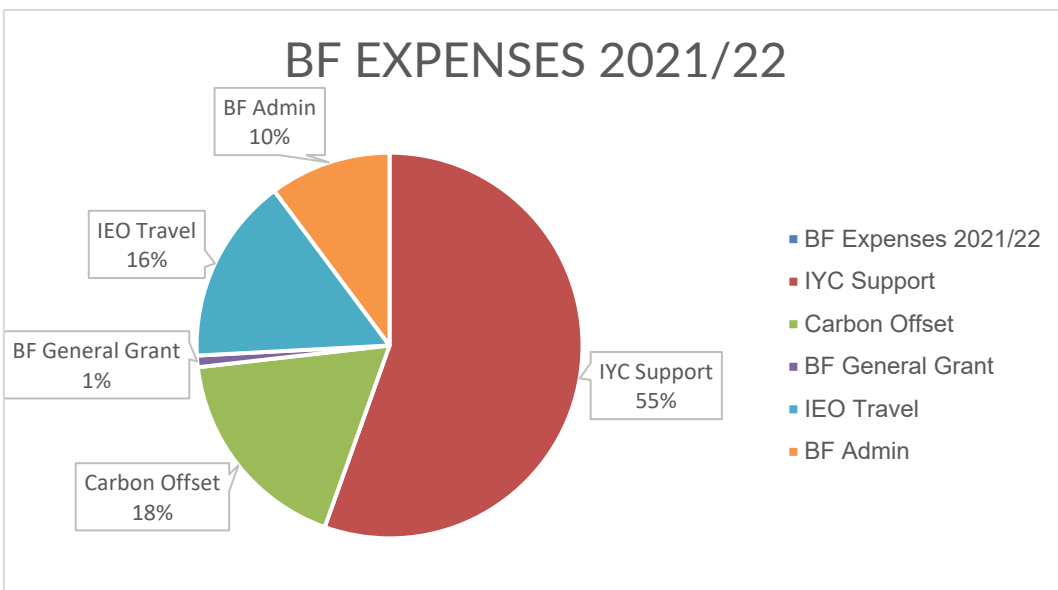
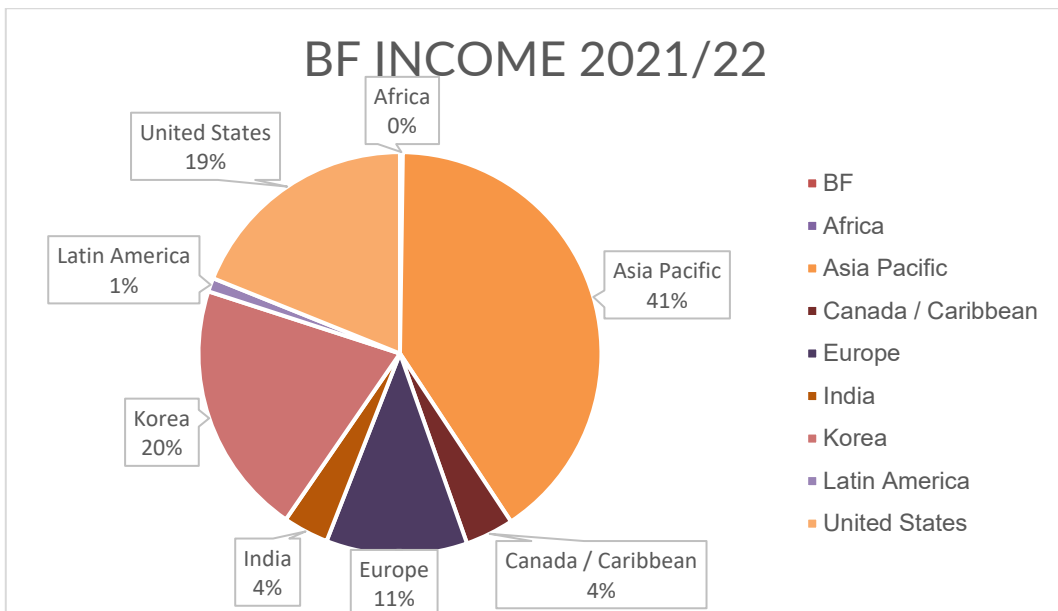
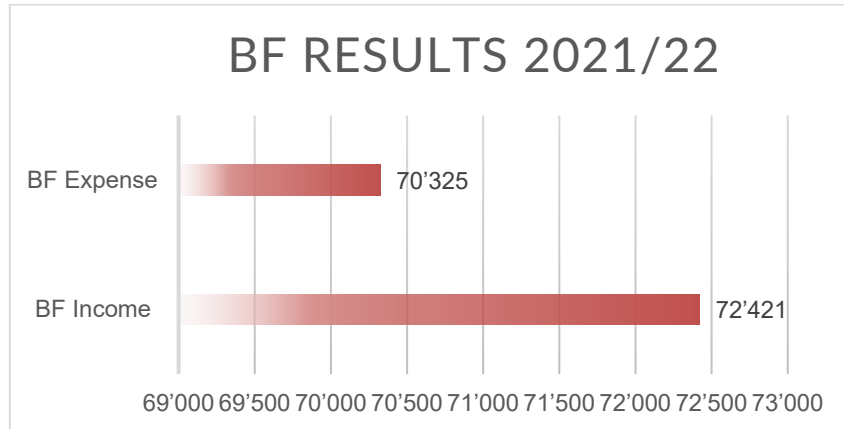




The Brotherhood Fund / Building Fellowship

The Endowment Fund

The Endowment Fund (EF)—provides financial stability for YMI's present and future purpose, objectives, programmes and expansion through a personalised, medium- risk portfolio. The fund is managed by EF Trustees who guide investments currently held with Pictet Bank.



Each year, based on returns, the EF Trustees may suggest the release of money, provided it does not touch the principal. In 2021/22 such funds were released for the International RDE Summit (CHF 25 000) and for the Special Development Support (CHF 25 000). (Voted by Council July 2021)

Every year YMI encourages donations to the Endowment Fund through a diverse gifts programme, originally conceived by Y's Men's Word editor, Dave Elder, in the 1960s. The 2021/21 EF honourees can be found on pages 46-50.

This year saw the introduction of the young Paul William Alexander Fellows, children and grandchildren of Y's Men members investing in the future of our movement.

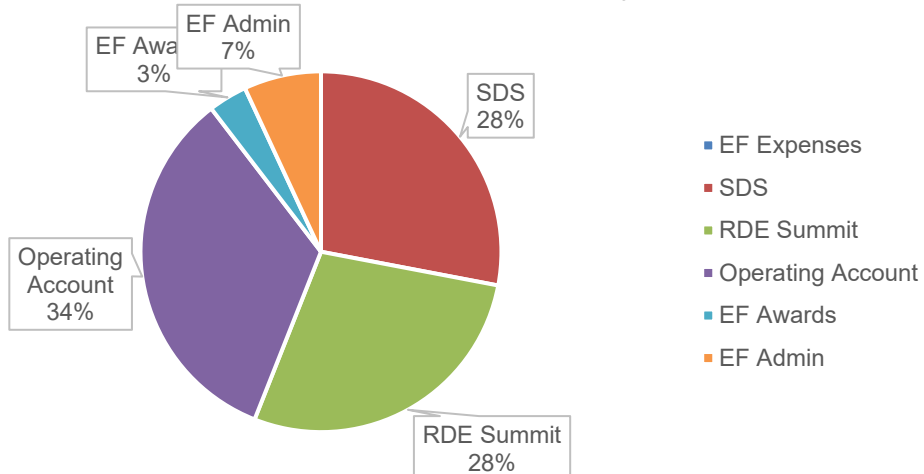

In honour of our three-year, multi-stakeholder agreement, CHF 100 000 was paid to the Global Fund, and we continue fighting to end malaria by 2030.

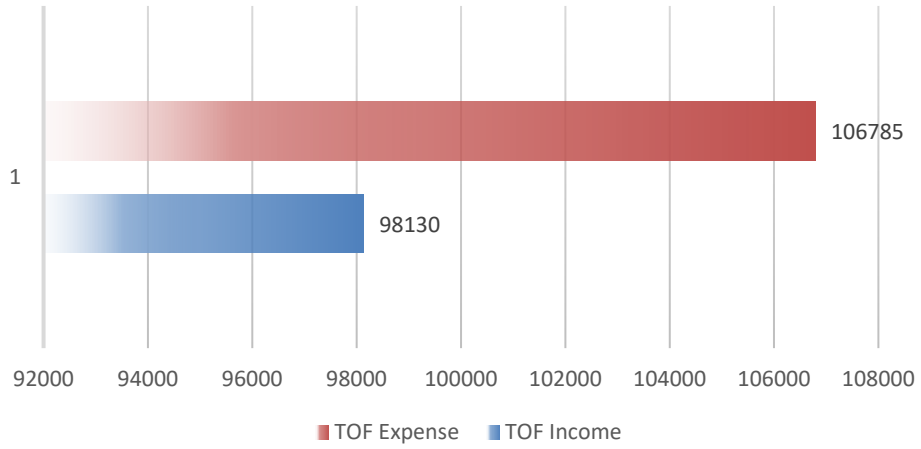

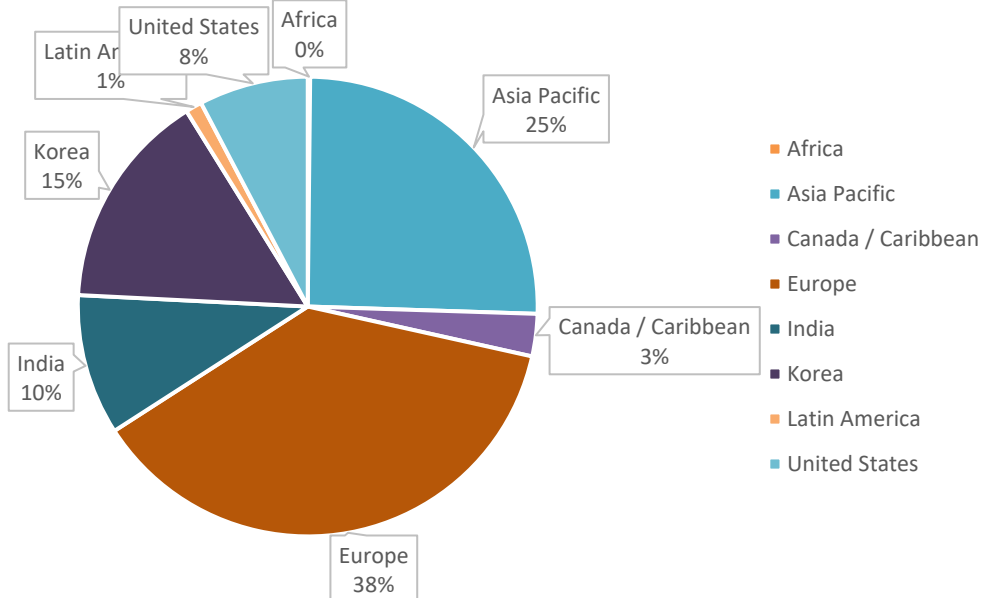

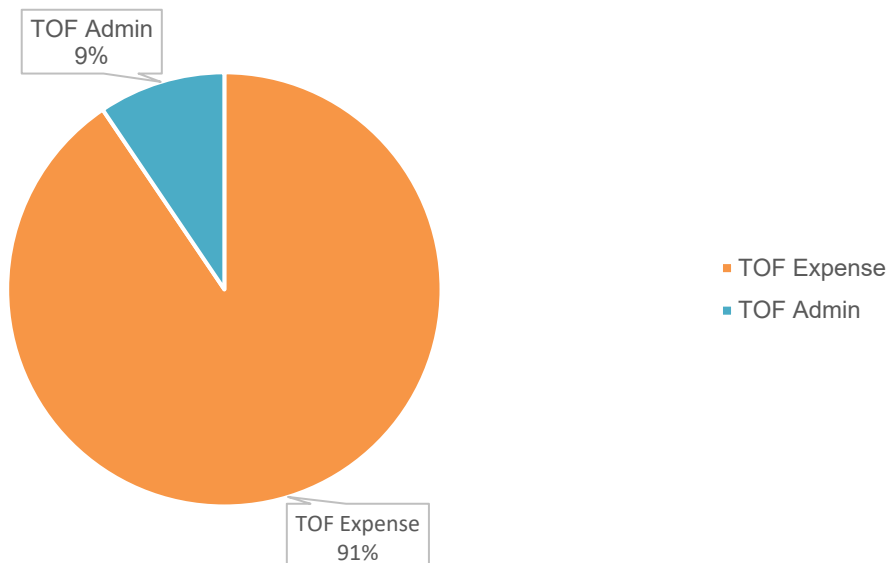
TOF RESULTS 2021/22

Y's Men International is committed to becoming an environmentally responsible organisation. Since 2010, we have acknowledged and accepted the need to reduce our environmental footprint. Every year, we support at least on YMI, YMCA or YMCA affiliate project aimed at bringing about enduring reductions in carbon emissions.

In the beginning of the year, CHF 2 476 was paid as the first 50% instalment to the Mandeville Y Service Club in Jamaica for solar water heaters as approved in 2020.

In October a first instalment was paid to the YMCA Makati and upon submission of a satisfactory report, the balance amount was released in early 2022 to successfully complete the project that should reduce annual emissions by around 36 tonnes per annum.

Week4Waste

Started by IPIP Jacob Kristensen in 2020, W4W has been a popular collective action in which all clubs can participate. Club are asked to conduct at least one 'clean-up' activity in their community during the year – for example, meeting to pick up trash left at a local park or beach. Multiple programmes and actions are encouraged, as well as cooperation with other NGOs or like-minded organisations. This has led to the collection and appropriate disposal of tons of rubbish across the globe.



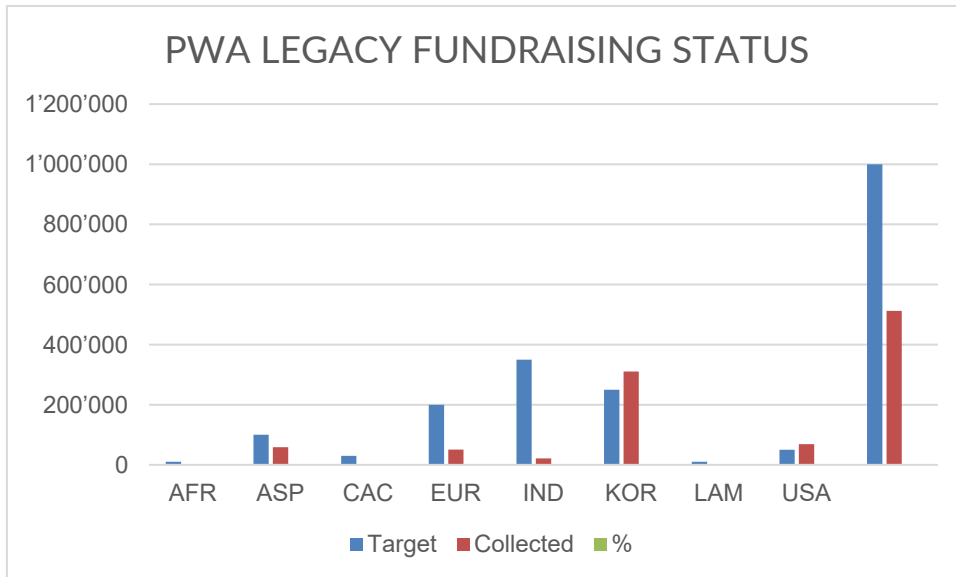
Paul William Alexander (PWA) Legacy

Special focus was given to two PWA Legacy projects in 2021/22: the purchase of an IHQ office in Geneva and digitisation of the archives.

The official fundraising period concluded this year with CHF 512 000 of the CHF 1 million target collected. Special recognition is due Areas Korea and United States for surpassing their contribution goals by 22% and 31% respectively. Although the Founder Legacy Task Force, founded in 2018 by IP Moon Sang-bong responsible for the creation of this extraordinary campaign to honour Paul William Alexander, was closed at

the end of 2021/22 year, money is still being received to realise the remaining projects.

The digital archives platform went live, and documents are in the process of being uploaded. Area and Regions have begun appointing administrators and preliminary training has been provided.

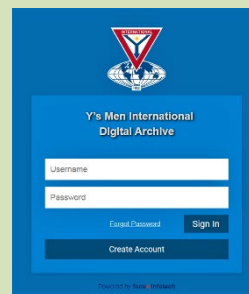

Health the World



- Decision to approve the Implementing Rules and Guidelines for the new Unified Global Project (voted by Council July 2021)

In 2021/22 donations totalled: CHF 91 561, the majority of which was raised for Ukraine relief efforts.

Ukraine

At the end February, YMI issued as an official statement seeking de-escalation and dialogue at the start of the conflict between Russia and

Ukraine. Initial support of USD 10 000 from the Heal the World fund was approved by the IP at MYM.

A partnership was created with YMCA Europe and the World YMCA to help address the humanitarian needs of all people affected by the war.

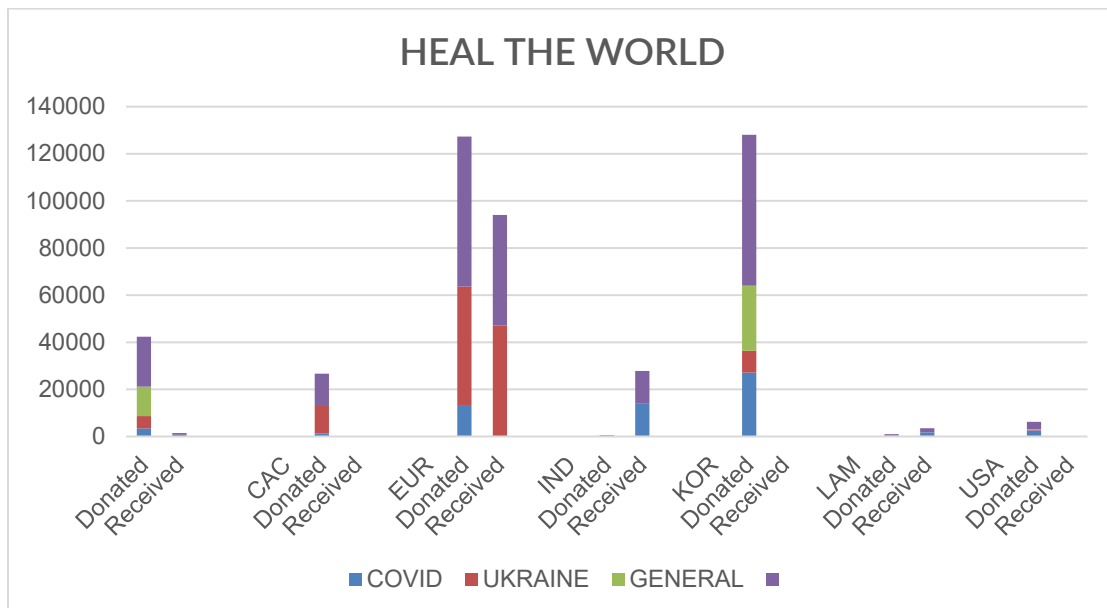
Our clubs in Moldova acted as first responders, setting up teams at all border crossing points between Moldova and Ukraine for distributing packages with essential food and hygiene products and offering temporary refuge to the more Ukrainians fleeing the conflict in February.



COVID-19

Other money from the HTW fund was used for COVID-19 relief activities in India, for a total amount of almost CHF 14 000, as well as to Nepal and Myanmar.

In total, more than CHF 166 000 has been raised for HTW emergency appeals since its launch and more than CHF 63 000 disbursed to help those in most urgent need.



Youth

YMI supported our youth in 2021/22 by sponsoring International Youth Representative Dwight Tomlinson's attendance at COOP 26 in Scotland. Dwight also became one of the first iGo interns. He will complete his placement with the Kosovo YMCA. A second internship with the YMCA Chiang Mai was awarded to Gert Gentalen from the Y's Men's Club of Pärnu in Estonia, which in turn has submitted an offer to host an intern. Other offers were submitted by YMCA Bombay and YMCA Sri Lanka. Applications for these positions will be processed in 2022/23.



IYR Krishnan Unni from Mid West India was elected in October as the IYR 2022-2024.



Youth Programme Assistant Tong and the International Youth Committee began to develop the programme of the first physical Youth Convocation to be held in two years, planned for September 2022 in Chiang Mai.

Y's Menettes

This year marked a serious review and update to the Y's Menettes manual, which included the introduction of election procedures for the International Director and the creation of a membership administrator, whose role will be to collect and manage data on active Y's Menettes clubs around the world.

This year, the Y's Menettes also voted to adopt a new international project. They selected to sponsor the educational and vocational training of poor young women in Katmandu, working with the NGO Society for Street children in Nepal, a Swedish organisation with ties to the Västerås Y's Men's Club. This programme was originally supported by Time of Fast funds in 2016.

Service Club Leaders' Conference

IPE Dr K.C. Samuel, ISG Jose Varghese and USA Area AP Shaju Sam attended the Service Club Leaders Conference (SCLC) in Orlando, Florida from 18-20 November 2021 hosted by Moose International.

The SCLC comprises American and international organisations or federations of local community-serving clubs represented by individuals coming together to create and strengthen cultural, spiritual, moral, business, and ethical standards and, through fellowship and altruism, to improve and expand impact. This year's conference focused on the effect of the COVID-19 pandemic on service clubs and on building future

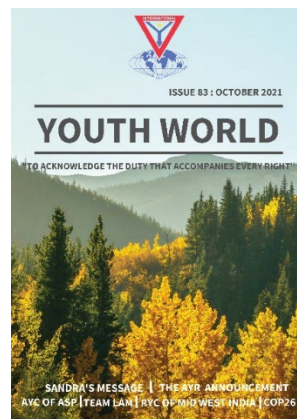
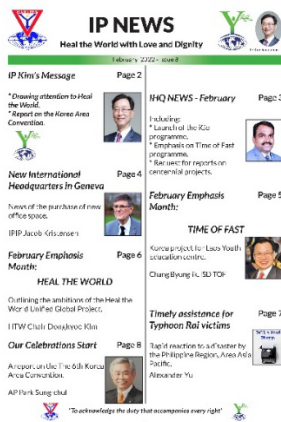


leadership. Sixty participants collectively engaged in a community service project - Clean the World. It was also an opportunity to meet with Triangle 2 Consulting friend, Tom and Lori.

PUBLICATIONS

There were monthly issues of IP News and Emphasis Months communications from IHQ. Four issues of Y's Men's World and two Youth World magazines were produced.

The iGo Manual, YMI Editorial Policy and the new International Youth Convocation Guidelines were approved in July 2021. The Manual Committee worked to update the ABC Manual, began developing an RBM pamphlet and updating the Introduction to Y's Men's International booklet. It also supported the revision of the Y's Menettes Manual.



180 DC Analysis

A final report was delivered by 180 DC, an independent consulting firm, on YMI in the United States and Canada. Below are the areas considered along with identified shortcomings and recommendations for improvement.

- **Marketing:** poor digital engagement
 - improve SEO
 - introduce a social media engagement plan
 - strengthen branding efforts
 - improve PR
- **Branding:** the individuality and autonomy of the clubs make achieving a corporate identity difficult
 - identify and universally reflect core values and messages throughout the movement to consolidate our movement into an easily identifiable brand, while encouraging distinctive personalities at the club level
- **Public Relations:** there is no real PR effort being made
 - determine the targeted demographic
 - share stories using all media forms
- **Membership:** Not enough is being done to incentivise potential members or to retain members facing challenges
 - assign new club members a mentor and responsibilities
 - reach out to the family of members who have passed away, they may be a source of recruitment later if not immediately
- **Measurements:** no clear definition of 'successes and ways to measure it. Include in currently available statistics
 - monetary and beneficiary impact
 - volunteer participation
- **Youth Engagement:** failure to engage and attract young people
 - develop and support student leadership programmes
 - build a stronger digital presence

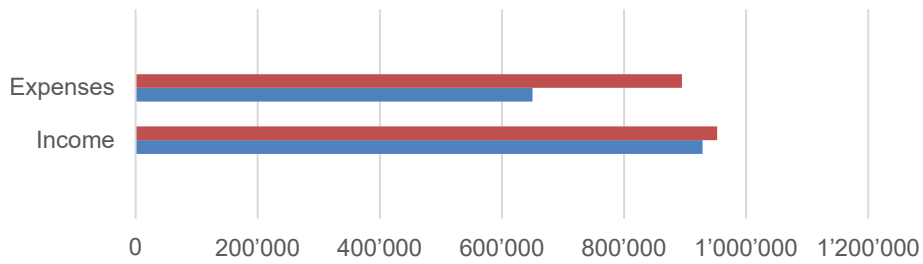

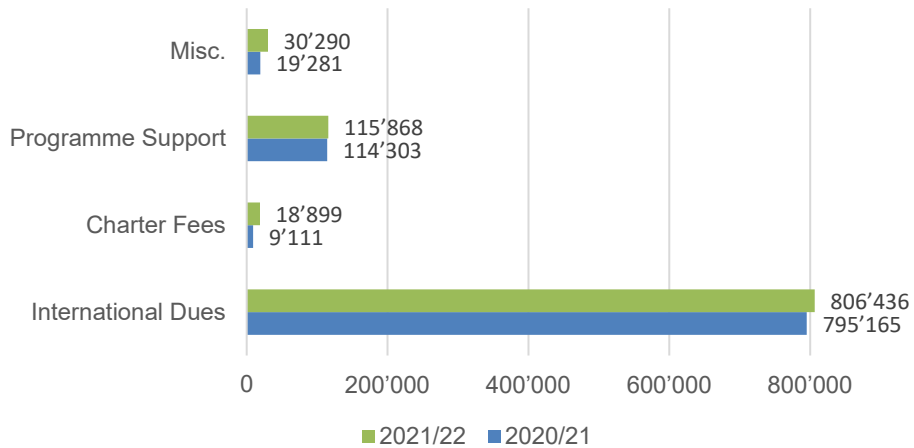
OPERATIONS - 2 YEARS

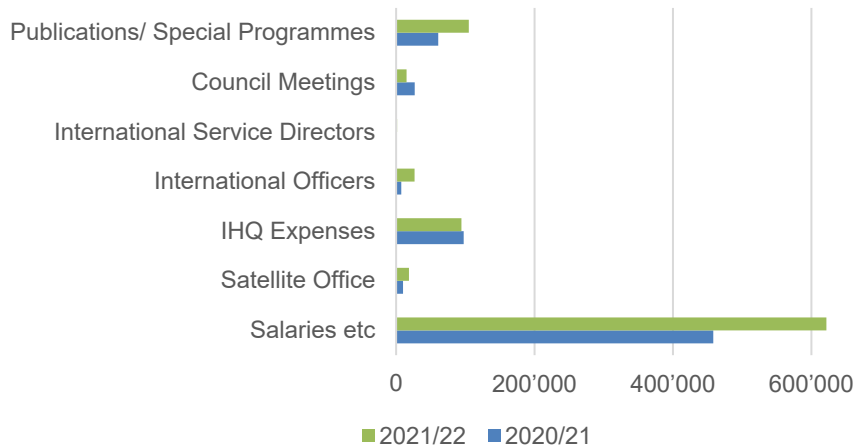

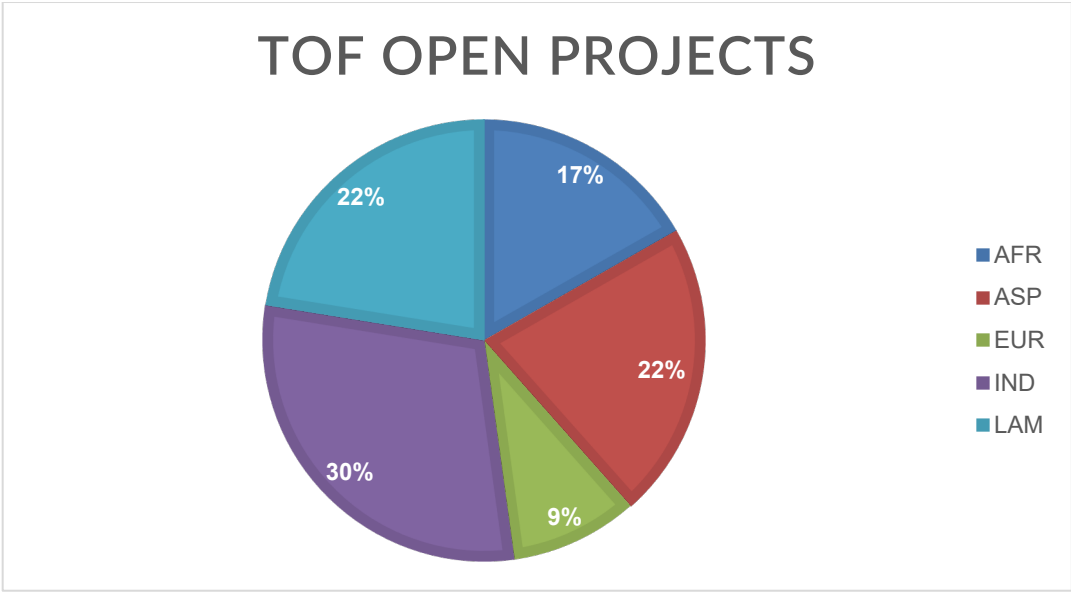
OPERATING EXPENSES - 2 YEARS



Director's Award
